Purpose: The African Food Fellowship Exchange Programme is a 3-month residency that aims to advance collaboration between researchers from an African based institution and researchers at Wageningen University & Research, who share an interest in the role of leadership in the transformation of African food systems. We are looking for **one** African and **one** Dutch junior researchers to partner with us in expanding the understanding of food systems leadership in African countries.

Eligibility: Upto 45 years of age; doctoral/ post-doctoral researchers; has finished data collection and interested in advancing their writing; identified willing supervisor in host research organisation; willing to complete the 3-month residency on full-time basis.
